



Brighton & Hove District Foresters Badge Course

We would like to invite any scout to attend a Foresters Badge Course; this will be held over two separate days making use of different seasons in the woodland.

Venue: - Parkwood Scout Camp, Henfield Road, Poynings, BN45 7BA.

Course Dates & Time: - Friday 16th at 19.00 to Saturday 17th October at 19.30
Saturday 14th November at 09.00 – 17.00

Course Fee: - £18.00

Equipment required: - Tent and sleeping equipment for Friday night.
Scout Scarf, appropriate clothing for weather, jacket & waterproofs(jacket and trousers).
Walking boots or Work boots (**no trainers**) for foot protection.
Packed lunch will be required for November session.

You must attend both sessions to be able to complete the Foresters Activity Badge

Course requirements are listed below:

1. Identify at least eight common types of tree growing in your area, including both deciduous and coniferous.
2. Find out how to identify trees using identification keys.
3. Prepare the soil and successfully transplant a young tree.
4. Find out how both natural woodland and commercial forests are managed. Be aware of the damage these areas may be exposed to from wind, frost, fire and animals.
5. Show how to select, use and care for forestry equipment, and know the safety issues involved.
6. Show how to fell and trim out a tree or know the principles of laying a hedge.

To book a place on the course please complete the attached form, and return it with the fee (*cheques payable to BRIGHTON & HOVE DISTRICT SCOUT COUNCIL*) by **Tuesday 13th October**. Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only completed forms which include payment will be accepted. Incomplete forms, or any received without payment will be returned.
